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Denotes new hedge planting as following specification:

Mixed hedge of hawthom 50%, hazel 15%, field maple 5%, native crab 5%, spindle 5%, guelder rose 5%, wild rose 5%, purging buckthom 5%, wayfaring tree 5%. Plant random mixture with hawthorn as dominant species & other plants in 3 or 5 of same species foorther as organs between hawthorn.

Denotes new Tree planting - Tree girth to be 12cm - 14cm and height between 3.5 - 4.0m. Excavate pit 50mm deeper and 500mm wider than the root ball. Break up base of pit. Backfill with mix of topsoil and compost. Dress with slow release fertiliser to manufacturer's recommendations. A 1 m ring of bare soil should be left around the base of each tree with a 75mm layer of bark mulch. Tree stakes to be minimum 75mm diameter, free of bark with one end pointed. Drive stake upright 450mm into bottom of excavated planting pit close to the tree stem on the windward side. Cut off at one-third the height of the tree and secure tree with approved ties and spacers at the top of the stake.

Root Barrier Membranes - For all proposed trees centred in a location within 3m of an adjacent hard standing/footpath or

Indicates Grassed Areas: Plots to be turfed, which should be a medium wear multipurpose turf to BS 3969, supporting flowering herb species. Laying is undertaken within 48hrs of lifting. If stacking, prior to laying, Stacks not to exceed 1.4m high. Turf should be transported over close-butted timber planks, which also protect the turf during laying. Turf is to be laid in executive rows and close butted breaking the joint in alternate rows. Consolidate lightly with wooden beaters. Brush in finely sieved topsoil to fill all joints – depth of 10mm. Ensure final surface is 20mm above any adjacent hard surface. Unless otherwise shown on the drawing, turf right up to existing established walls, fences and similar obstructions, leaving no soil uncovered.

Areas of open space and areas supporting trees outside of formal ownership within the formal residential development will be sown with EMZ Meadow Mixture and established as per the manufacture's instructions. Areas to be seeded are to be finely graded to bring to a uniform and even grade at the correct finished level and to remove all minor hollows and ridges. All stones and debris greater than 35mm in size to be removed and disposed of off-site. Seeded areas are to consist of min. 250mm toposit, either existing retained site sourced toposit (free from weeds) or imported
